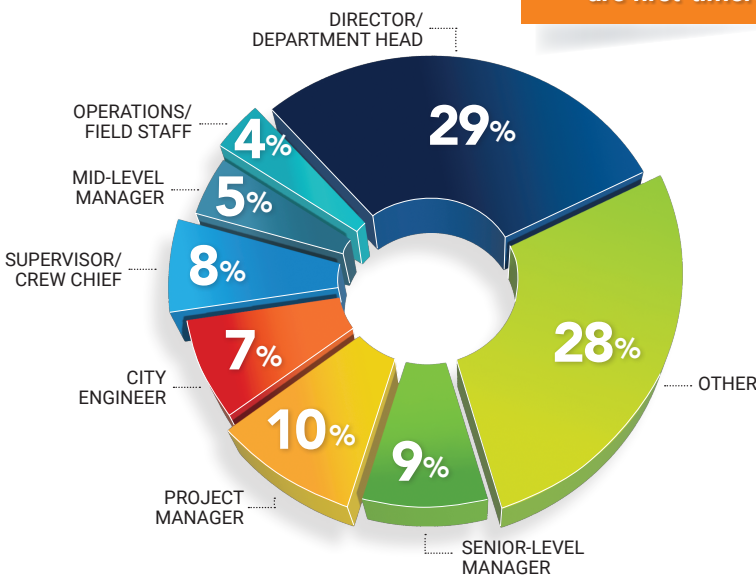
PWX is the largest annual gathering of its kind, bringing together more than 5,000 public works professionals dedicated to serving and protecting their communities.

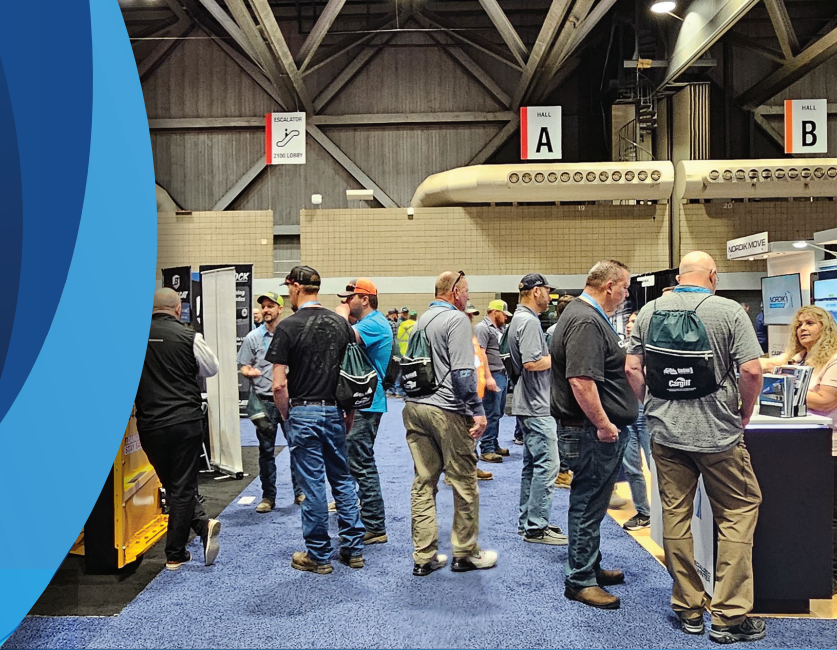

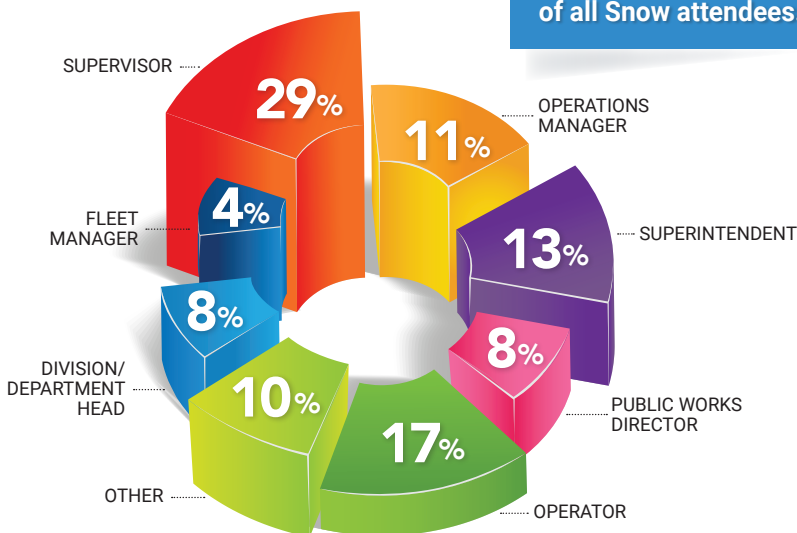
ABOUT
