Certified Public Infrastructure Inspector (CPII)

The purpose of the Public Infrastructure Inspector Certification is to promote quality infrastructure throughout the community by advancing the knowledge and practice of construction inspection to benefit the community and public agencies.

The Certified Public Infrastructure Inspector certification program is intended for individuals that inspect the construction of public infrastructure (e.g., roadways, highways, utilities, bridges, dams) and facilities (e.g., pump stations, treatment plants, water storage facilities) and other types of construction work and materials to ensure compliance with plans and specifications. Duties may include observation, measurement, testing, and documentation.

Step 1: Applying for Eligibility

To demonstrate eligibility, candidates must submit an application documenting the completion of the following requirements:

- Minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum five years of public infrastructure inspection field experience.

Eligibility Application Fee:

\$95 – APWA members;

\$145 – Nonmembers

Step 2: Taking the Exam

The exam consists of 150 multiple-choice questions based on the CPII Content Outline. Candidates are given a minimum of 3.5 hours to complete the exam. Preparation for the exam includes review of the CPII Content Outline and Recommended Reading List. Exams are computer-based and can be administered directly to the candidate at their place of employment, through a testing center or remotely via the record and review process.

Exam Application Fee:

\$300

Step 3: Navigating Recertification

After successful completion of the exam, candidates become certified for a period of five years.

Prior to the end of the five-year period, Certified Public Infrastructure Inspectors must complete a **minimum of 50 credits** earned through a combination of continuing education and contributions to the profession.

\$95 – APWA members;

\$145 – Nonmembers
